- 1 Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in lines 165 and 166 the words "one hundred
- 3 and seventy-five" and inserting in place thereof the following:-- "two hundred and fifty".
