An Act relative to telemarketing solicitation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 159C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following words:-
- 3           The telephone number listed in the identification service or device shall be a legitimate  
4   number in which the consumer can directly communicate with the solicitor.
