**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to room rental rates.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 64G of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after subsection (j), the following new subsection:

4 (k) “Friends and Family Rate”, rooms rented to employees of an operator and relatives
5 and friends of employees at a rate determined by the operator.

6 SECTION 2. Subsection (j) of Section 1 of Chapter 64G is hereby amended by inserting
7 after the word “whatsoever.”, the following: “Rent for rooms rented under a friends and family
8 rate shall be based solely on the rate determined by the operator.”
