Bradley for an investigation by a special commission (including members of the General Court) relative to the construction of a state indoor track facility in the southeastern region of the Commonwealth. Resolve establishing a special commission to investigate and study the feasibility of constructing a Massachusetts state indoor track facility in southeastern Massachusetts.

- 1 Resolved, that a special commission be established to investigate and study the feasibility 2 of constructing a Massachusetts State Indoor Track Facility in southeastern Massachusetts. The 3 study shall include, but not be limited to design features of any such facility, costs of 4 construction, financing strategies, timeline for development and construction, administration of 5 any such facility, and the siting of any such facility. 6 The commission shall be comprised of the following 13 members: 2 members of the 7 senate appointed by the senate president; 2 members of the house of representatives appointed by 8 the speaker of the house; 1 member of the senate and 1 member of the house of representatives 9 appointed by the minority leader of each; the secretary of administration and finance or his
- 10 designee; the commissioner of the division of capital asset management and maintenance, or his

11 designee; the commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation, or his designee; a

- 12 representative of the Massachusetts State Track Coaches Association; a representative of the
- 13 Massachusetts Interscholastic Athletic Association; a representative of the Massachusetts

Secondary Schools Athletic Directors Association; and a student scholar athlete who participatesin track and field.

- 16 The commission shall report to the general court the results of its study together with
- 17 recommendations and drafts of legislation by filing the same with the clerks of the senate and the
- 18 house of representatives on or before December 31, 2015.
