In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act declaring the second Monday in October as "Italian-American Heritage Day".

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 12V of Chapter 6 of is hereby amended by striking out the words "Columbus
- 2 Day" and inserting in place thereof-
- 3 -Italian-American Heritage Day
- 4 Section 12V of Chapter 6 is hereby further amended by striking out "Christopher
- 5 Columbus, discoverer of America, may be perpetuated." and inserting in place thereof-
- 6 -Italian-Americans and their contributions to the cultural, economic, and political
- 7 landscape of the Commonwealth may be perpetuated.
