*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 73(b) of Chapter 118E of the Massachusetts General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following phrase at the end of the first sentence in that  
3 subsection”
- 4           “; and employees of an agency of the commonwealth for the purposes of clause twenty  
5 six (o) of section seven of chapter four.”
