An Act to maintain the integrity of the public records law.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the general laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in clause twenty-six, in the first paragraph, after the
3 words “or of any political subdivision thereof”, the following words:-

4 “; or a non-profit corporation formed by a political subdivision or its departments,”
