An Act relative to the distribution of the conflict of interest law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 27 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out, in line 4, the words “county and municipal”

3 SECTION 2. Section 27 of Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
4 inserting at the end of the paragraph the following sentence:-

5 Every county and municipal employee shall, within 30 days of becoming such an  
6 employee, and upon any instance of changes to this chapter thereafter, be furnished with a  
7 summary of this chapter prepared by the commission and sign a written acknowledgment that he  
8 has been provided with such a summary.
