### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the STEM Advisory Council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 217 of Chapter 6 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as amended by Section 12
- of Chapter 165 of the Acts of 2014, shall be amended in subsection (c) by striking out the
- 3 number 30 in the first sentence and replacing it with the following 35; and by adding at the end
- 4 of said subsection the following: provided further, that not less than 12 members of the Council
- 5 shall represent companies that employ STEM professionals.
