An Act establishing an electric vehicle consumer rebate program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 25A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012

Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the third paragraph the following new

3 paragrpahs:-

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Said commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to establish a grant program providing rebates to consumers who purchase or lease a qualifying plug-in electric vehicle. For the purpose of this section, qualified vehicles are those that (a) are made by a manufacturer primarily for use on public streets, roads and highways, (b) have not been modified from the original manufacturer's specifications, (c) have been acquired for use or lease by the consumer and not for resale, (d) have a shipping weight not exceeding 8,500 pounds, (e) have a speed capability of at least 55 miles per hour, (f) are capable of being recharged from an external source of electricity and (g) must be propelled to a significant extent by an electric motor that draws electricity from a battery. The initial rebate for vehicles with a battery capacity of 10

- kilowatt-hours or more shall be \$2500. The rebate for vehicles with a battery capacity of not less
- than 4 kilowatt-hours, buy less than 10 kilowatt-hours shall be \$1500.
- The commissioner is hereby authorized to promulgate rules and regulations for the
- 16 electric vehicle consumer rebate program.
