Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Chapter 23K of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 72. Upon application the commission may license a private club to operate a

3 gaming device. Each such gaming device operated in a private club shall be separately licensed

pursuant to regulations promulgated by the commission. As used in this section the term

5 "private club" shall mean a not-for-profit entity that is comprised of members who collectively

6 belong to (i) a veterans' organization incorporated or chartered by the Congress of the United

7 States, or otherwise, having 1 or more affiliated chapters or branches incorporated in any state;

8 or (ii) a society, organization or association of a fraternal nature that operates under the lodge

9 system, and have 1 or more affiliated chapters or branches incorporated in any state.
