In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to decrease the Veterans' Plate fee.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by striking out, in line 390, the words ", upon application," and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the words:- "without charge"
- 4 Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby further amended
- 5 by striking out, in line 397 to 399, the words "There shall be an annual \$20 fee for such
- 6 "VETERAN" plates in addition to the established registration fee for private passenger vehicles
- 7 and motorcycles." and inserting in place thereof the words:- "The surviving spouse of a deceased
- 8 veteran may elect to retain such distinctive registration plates or emblem for personal use upon
- 9 payment of the established registration fee for private passenger motor vehicles or motorcycles

- and an additional annual twenty dollar fee until such time as such spouse remarries or fails to
- 11 renew or cancels such registration."
