An Act designating a certain section of State Highway Route 2 in the city of Cambridge and town of Arlington as the James M. Gavin Memorial Highway.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the section of  
2 state highway route 2 in the City of Cambridge and the Town of Arlington spanning the portion  
3 from Concord Avenue in Cambridge to the junction at Pleasant Street in Arlington shall be  
4 designated and known as the James M. Gavin memorial highway, in honor of General James M.  
5 Gavin. The Department of Transportation shall erect suitable markers bearing such designation  
6 in compliance with the standards of the department.
