An Act related to the enhancement of public safety to children in the vicinity of an attractive nuisance, a motor vehicle with the purpose of selling frozen desserts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 101 section 16A of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2   inserting the following new section:

3           Section 2. If a motor vehicle is stopped on a road for the purpose of selling frozen  
4   desserts without a functioning and operating amber dome light, or front and rear warning lights,  
5   said vehicle shall be subject to a citation and fine of one hundred dollars to be issued by any law  
6   enforcement officer.
