In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act establishing mileage based numbering for exits along interstate highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 85 of the General	l Laws is hereby amend	led by adding the following:

3 The exit numbers along all interstate highways within Massachusetts shall be converted

4 to a mileage-based system. The plan will include the following provisions:

- 5 (a) As closely as practicable, follow the Federal Highway Administration mileage-
- 6 based exit numbering system
- 7 (b) Follow the convention that the numbering shall start at the southernmost or
- 8 westernmost terminus of the interstate highway

² Section XX-

- 9 (c) Minimize costs by using existing roadside and overhead signs whenever possible
- 10 (d) For a period of two years the exit number of each exit prior to such conversion
 11 shall also be displayed at each exit
- 12 (e) The mileage-based exit numbering system shall be completed on or before
- 13 January 1, 2017
