In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to changing the minimum age requirement for Kindergarten.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The twenty-first paragraph of section 1B of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing

2 in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- The

3 mandatory minimum age for attendance of kindergarten shall be for a child 5 years of age for

4 attendance in the school year beginning in September of the calendar year in which he or she

5 attains the age of 5.
