*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 7C of Chapter 89 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended is hereby amended by inserting after the words “recovery vehicle” in line 18
- 3 the following words:- “or any vehicle operated by a civilian”
