An Act relative to Route 128 interchange improvements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Massachusetts Highway Department is hereby directed to create a
2 timeline of implementation of the completed plan for interchange improvements along Route
3 128, from the City of Peabody to the City of Gloucester. The completed study includes the
4 traffic patterns along the corridor, improvements and or reconstruction of interchanges, upgrades
5 to the acceleration and deceleration lanes. A report of the implementation plan shall include a
6 proposed start date and date of completion. The result is to be delivered to the Joint Committee
7 on Transportation no later than December 31, 2016.
