Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

2 inserting after the word "curriculum" in line 67 the following language:-

3 In addition to classroom and road training, a student shall complete a supervised

4 defensive driving course, a form of training for motor vehicle drivers that goes beyond mastery

5 of the rules of the road and the basic mechanics of driving with an aim to reduce the risk of

6 collision by anticipating dangerous situations, despite adverse conditions or the mistakes of

7 others. The course must comply with ANSI/ASSE Z15.1 and be approved by the Registry of

8 Motor Vehicles.
