Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 399 after the word “motorcycles.”:-“The
3 Registrar shall furnish, without charge, a “VETERAN” plate at the request of an operator who is
4 eligible for a Disabled Veteran plate under this section,”

5 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
6 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 439 after the word “who”:-“, is eligible
7 for a Disabled Veteran plate under this section,”
