An Act An act exempting veterans from paying tolls.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 10 of chapter 81A of the General Laws, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph: - The authority shall not charge or collect a toll for  
3 transit over the turnpike and the different parts and sections thereof by private passenger vehicles  
4 registered to veterans, as certified by the United States Department of Defense. The authority  
5 shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the provisions of this paragraph.

6 Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 10 of Chapter 81A of the General Laws is hereby  
7 amended by adding the following paragraph: - The authority shall not charge or collect a toll for  
8 transit through the Callahan Tunnel, the Sumner Tunnel, or the Ted Williams Tunnel by private  
9 passenger vehicles registered to veterans, as certified by the United States Department of  
10 Defense. The authority shall issue passes or stickers to carry out the provisions of this paragraph.
