*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           An Act relative to Massachusetts Civil Air Patrol vehicles and trailers.

2           SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as  
3 appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "fire  
4 fighting purposes," the following words:- and every motor vehicle or trailer owned and operated  
5 by the United States Air Force Auxiliary Massachusetts Civil Air Patrol,.
