An Act relative to student driver safety.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 8B of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           The registrar shall provide the holder of a learner's permit with a highly visible,  
4 reflective decal indicating that the driver of the vehicle may be the holder of a learner's permit.  
5 The registrar may charge a fee for the decal. The decal shall be displayed in a manner prescribed  
6 by the registrar, and shall be clearly visible to law enforcement officers. The holder of a learner's  
7 permit shall not operate a vehicle unless the decal is so displayed. Any individual found  
8 operating a motor vehicle in violation of this paragraph shall be punished by a fine of not more  
9 than \$50. The registrar is hereby authorized to promulgate regulations to assure the timely and  
10 effective implementation of this paragraph.
