An Act relative to the appointment of veterans' agents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,  
2   is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the words “, annually in April,” and inserting after  
3   the word “agent” in line 2, the following words:— who shall serve for a term of up to three years  
4   and be eligible for reappointment.
