**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act Relative to Military Service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 4 of the General Laws, in section 7, forty-third clause, is hereby amended by
2 striking out part 3 and inserting in place thereof the following: (3) any person (a) whose last
3 discharge from active service was under honorable conditions, and who (b) served in the army,
4 navy, marine corps, coast guard, national guard, or air force of the United States.
