**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to compensating a family member as caretaker.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a family
2 member may be the designated paid caretaker for a member of the family with a traumatic brain
3 injury received while in military service. The prerequisites for this designation by the
4 department of public health and any other department shall include, but not be limited to,
5 training and certification.
