- SECTION 1. Subsection (n) of section 5 of chapter 31 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 2010 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "instances", in line
- 3 58, the following words:-; provided, however, that a veteran shall not be charged any fee for any
- 4 examination provided by this chapter.
- 5 SECTION 2. Section 20 of said chapter 31, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- 6 inserting after the word "four", in line 7, the following words:-; provided, however, that a
- 7 veteran shall not be charged any fee for any examination provided by this chapter.
