# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An act relative to the removal of commemorative flag holders from the graves of veterans and certain police and fire personnel..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 73 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition,
is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words "veteran's grave marker or metal
plaque or flag" and inserting in place thereof the following words: — American flag, veteran's
grave marker, metal plaque, veteran's commemorative flag holder, commemorative flag holder
representing service in both the police and fire department.
