An Act enhancing public awareness of tax and fee increases.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 38B the  
2 following section:-

3           Section 38B½. The committee on ways and means of each branch of the general court  
4 shall conduct no less than 6 public hearings on bills referred to them that purport to establish,  
5 increase or expand any new or existing taxes or fees. The committees shall give 3 days' public  
6 notice prior to holding such public hearings. Each hearing shall be conducted in a distinct  
7 geographical region of the commonwealth.
