## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Deborah Hawkins, an employee of the Office of the State Auditor.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the office of the state auditor, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the office of the state auditor  
2 shall establish a sick leave bank for Deborah Hawkins, an employee of the office. Any employee  
3 of the office may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick  
4 leave bank for use by Deborah Hawkins. If Deborah Hawkins terminates employment with the  
5 office or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall  
6 be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for  
7 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
8 bank as determined by the office.
