**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to SNAP work requirements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 18 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 32 the
2 following section:--

3 Section 32A. The department shall not seek, apply for, accept or renew any waiver of
4 work requirements for the supplemental nutrition assistance program established under 7 U.S.C.
5 § 2015(o); provided that waivers shall be granted for individuals with protected status or good
6 cause as allowed by federal and state law.
