An Act relative to smoking cessation.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 101A of chapter 41 is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and  
2     inserting in place thereof the following 3 sentences:-- Any employee found to be in violation of  
3     this section shall be offered an opportunity to enter a smoking cessation program prior to  
4     termination. The personnel administrator shall promulgate regulations for the implementation of  
5     this section. Nothing in this section shall preclude the personnel administrator from continuing  
6     smoking cessation programs, not detailed in this section, that are currently in practice.
