By Mr. Dooley of Norfolk, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3407) of Shawn Dooley and Chris Walsh for legislation to establish electronic scanning for voters to expedite the check-in and check-out procedures at polling places. Election Laws.

An Act to decrease waiting times at polling places.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 54 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 144. (a) The state secretary shall provide for a program to allow cities and towns
3 to implement a voter speed pass system in addition to the manual system currently used by cities
4 and towns. The purpose of the program shall be to reduce wait times for voters at polling places.
5 The program shall allow voter information to be electronically scanned in order to check-in and
6 check-out of the polling location.

7 (b) The program shall use software approved by the state secretary. The software shall
8 meet the highest security ratings available. The program shall utilize an electronic poll book, if
9 available to the city or town, to verify voter information. The verification shall be directly
10 uploaded back into the commonwealth's voter registration information system, in addition to the
11 manual system that is currently in place.
