## In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court

 (2015-2016)An Act relative to the qualification of voters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "conviction", in line 3, the following words:- for a violation of section $13,13 b, 13 b 1 / 2,16$ or 24 of chapter 265 or for which the person may be punished by imprisonment in a state prison for life.
