An Act relative to correctional employees' retirement reinstatement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 105 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the words “5 or section 10” and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following words:- section 5, 10, 28M or 28N.
