An Act authorizing Quincy College to confer baccalaureate degrees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The Board of Governors of Quincy College is authorized and empowered to  
2 grant baccalaureate degrees.

3           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
