An Act authorizing the town of Sudbury to amend Chapter 169 of the Acts of 2012.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 169 of the Acts of 2012 is hereby amended by striking Section 8  
2           thereof in its entirety.

3           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a vote of the Town of  
4           Sudbury at the next special or annual town election held at least 45 days after enactment.
