# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act Relative to Student Online Information Protection Policies.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 71 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2012 Official		
2	Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 94 the following new section:		
3	Section 95. Student Online Information Protection Policies		
4	(a) An operator of an Internet Web site, online service, online application, or mobile		
5	application with actual knowledge that the site, service, or application is used for K-12 school		
6	purposes and was designed and marketed for K-12 school purposes shall comply with all of the		
7	following requirements:		
8	i. It shall not use, share, disclose, or compile personal information about a K-12		
9	student for any purpose other than the K-12 school purpose and for maintaining the integrity of		
10	) the site, service, or application.		
11	ii. It shall not use, share, disclose, or compile a student's personal information for		
12	any commercial purpose, including but not limited to, advertising or profiling.		

- 13 iii. It shall not allow, facilitate, or aid in the marketing or advertising of a product or
  14 service to a k-12 student on the site, service, or application.
- 15 iv. It shall take all reasonable steps to protect the data at rest and in motion in a
- 16 manner that meets or exceeds commercial best practice.
