An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Raoul Santos, an employee of the Military Division.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Military Division shall  
2   establish a sick leave bank for Raoul Santos, an employee of the Military Division. Any  
3   employee of the Military Division may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
4   vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Raoul Santos. Whenever Raoul Santos terminates  
5   employment with the Military Division or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any  
6   remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the Military Division paid leave  
7   bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability  
8   that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the Military Division.
