An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Boston as The Honorable Arthur J. Lewis, Jr. Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The bridge on the West Roxbury Parkway, in the West Roxbury section of the city of  
2 Boston, shall be designated and known as The Honorable Arthur J. Lewis, Jr. Bridge in honor of  
3 Arthur J. Lewis, Jr. who served in the Massachusetts House of Representatives for the Eight  
4 Suffolk District from 1967-1972 and in the Massachusetts Senate for the First Suffolk and  
5 Norfolk District from 1973-1991. The Massachusetts Highway Department shall erect and  
6 maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the  
7 department.
