**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to signing of warrants for payment in the town of Tyngsborough.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provision of section 56 of chapter 41 of the General
2 laws, or of any other general or special law to the contrary,; the town administrator in the town of
3 Tyngsborough, and in the absence of the town administrator the assistant town administrator,
4 may approve all warrants for payment of town funds including payroll warrants. The approval of
5 all such warrants by the town administrator or in the town administrator’s absence the assistant
6 town administrator shall be sufficient to authorize payment by the town treasurer, , but a majority
7 of the board of selectmen shall approve all such warrants in the event of the absence of said town
8 administrator, or assistant town administrator, or a vacancy in the office of town administrator.
