An Act relative to testing requirements for veterans who wish to become educators.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as amended by section 22 of chapter 226  
2 of the acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           Any veteran, as defined by clause Forty-third of section 7 of chapter 4, who is  
4 administered a test established pursuant to this section required for certification as a provisional  
5 educator or a provisional educator with advanced standing shall receive 5 additional points to be  
6 added to the total test scaled score.
