Koczera and others (with the approval of the mayor and city council) that the city of New Bedford be authorized to compensate instructors at a regional school district for their services as elected municipal officials in said city. In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)

An Act relative to regional school district instructors service as an elected official in the city of New Bedford.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any Instructor
2 at a Regional School District receiving a salary for their services as such an Instructor shall also
3 be eligible to additionally receive the established salary for their services as an elected Municipal
4 Official in the City of New Bedford.

5 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
