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**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

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**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**  
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An Act relative to the town of Northborough and the sale of all alcoholic beverages.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17, of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2           licensing authority for the town of Milford may grant one 1 additional license for the sale of  
3           wines and malt beverages not to be drunk on premises pursuant to section 15 of chapter 138, to  
4           Water Street Meat Market, LLC, 3 Water street, in the town of Milford. The license shall be  
5           subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6           (b) Once issued, the licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of the license  
7           granted pursuant to this act to any other location. The license may be re-issued by the licensing  
8           authority at the same location if an applicant for the license files with the licensing authority a  
9           letter from the department of revenue and a letter from the department of unemployment  
10          assistance indicating that the license is in good standing with those departments and that all  
11          applicable taxes, fees and contributions have been paid.

12          (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, it  
13          shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions pertaining

14 thereto, to the licensing authority which may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same  
15 location and under the same conditions as specified in this act.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
