To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives,

Pursuant to Article LVI, as amended by Article XC, Section 3 of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, I am returning to you for amendment House Bill No. 3657, "An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Jeremy Bray, an Employee of the Department of Correction."

Sick leave banks are established to provide much needed relief to state employees who have exhausted all leave time due to serious medical challenges. Sick leave banks are funded by those employees' generous colleagues, who contribute their own vacation, sick and/or personal time. In this case, we have learned that Mr. Bray is a member of the Extended Illness Leave Bank and is eligible for the maximum withdrawal of 120 days. Accordingly, he does not have an immediate need for a sick leave bank.

I, therefore, recommend that House Bill No. 3657 be amended by inserting after the end of the second sentence, the following sentence:-

"Upon exhaustion of all other available leave time including personal days, vacation days, sick time and any time available pursuant to the extended leave illness bank established by section 4P of chapter 7 of the General Laws, Jeremy Bray shall be permitted to use any time credited to the sick leave bank established by this act."
