In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Amend Chapter 71, Section 89, subsection (ii) in the 2010 Edition of the General Laws
- 2 by striking out the subsection and replacing it with words "No teacher shall be hired by a
