An Act promoting job training in the commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14L of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 6 to 11, the words "To the extent 3 consistent with federal law, the commissioner shall adjust the rate of said contribution so that the 4 total amount of said contributions in a year substantially equals \$22,000,000, and shall adjust to 5 the same extent the rate of the contribution required by section 14." 6 SECTION 2. Said section 14L, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting 7 after the word "proceeds", in line 11, the following words:- "up to the amount of \$22,000,000," 8 SECTION 3. Said section 14L, as so appearing, is hereby further amended by inserting 9 after the figure "14C", in line 20, the following new subsection:- (c) All proceeds in excess of 10 \$22,000,000 shall be administered by the Executive Office of Labor and Workforce 11 Development, including but not limited to the Commonwealth Corporation, and deposited in the 12 Workforce Competitiveness Trust Fund, established by Chapter 29 Section 2WWW.
