An Act authorizing the city of Everett to establish a linkage fee revolving fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding Section 53 of Chapter 44 of the General Laws, or any other
2 general or special law to the contrary, the

3 City of Everett may establish a separate fund to be known as the Linkage Fee Revolving
4 Fund which shall be kept separate and

5 apart from all other monies of the City by the City Treasurer and into which shall be
6 deposited all linkage fees received by the City

7 of Everett. The fund shall be used for the maintenance of streets, parks and public
8 recreational facilities within the City of Everett

9 and the Mayor shall administer the funds for said purposes. The Treasurer may invest
10 such funds in the manner authorized by

- 11 Sections 54 of said Chapter 44.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
