An Act to amend Section 9 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 9 of Chapter 115 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out “Upon  
2 the approval of the commissioner, compensation for 75 per cent of the cost of such flags” and  
3 replacing in its place thereof the following sentence: -

4           “Upon the approval of the commissioner, compensation for 90 per cent of the cost of  
5 such flags if the flags are manufactured in Massachusetts.”
