**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to the safety and well-being of children in the custody of the department of children and families.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to forthwith require the department of children and families to report on the safety and well-being of children, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. On or before November 17, 2015, the department of children and families  
2 shall report to the house and senate committees on ways and means and the joint committee on  
3 children, families and persons with disabilities on any new or updated policies, procedures and  
4 guidelines put into place at the department over the last year in order to provide systemic  
5 improvements that shall ensure the safety and well-being of children in the custody of the  
6 department and in-home placements and shall provide an update on the progress made in each  
7 area. The report shall include any performance benchmarks used to assess new or updated

8 policies as well as any procedures the department will take to improve its evaluation of children  
9 suspected of abuse or neglect.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of November 2, 2015.
